STATEMENT

I was flying No. 2 man on wing of Major Don M. Beerbower who was leading 353rd Fighter Squadron on an armed reconnaissance mission. We went down to strafe an airfield north of Reims. Our first pass was from North to South, firing at twin-engine e/a in revetments. I noticed Major Beerbower got hits on an e/a. We came off the field, circled. to the right and made a pass from East to West to knock out gun emplacements as Blue and Green flights made a pass at planes in revetments. As we came in range, in line-abreast formation, the guns opened fire on us and we returned the fire. Major Beerbower silenced one gun and pulled up straight as we left. I saw hits on his wing and the canopy was gone. The plane was climbing and it appeared that the Major was hit. plane climbed until it partially stalled, half-rolled and nosed straight down in a dive, exploding when it hit the ground. The pilot fell free while it was in the vertical dive, but no apparent attempt was made to open his 'chute.




STATEMENT

I was flying Red Three position, 353rd Fighter Squadron, on an armed reconnaissance mission. We went in and strafed the airdrome north of Reims. On the first pass, Major Don M. Beerbower, Squadror Leader, destroyed a Ju-88 in the revetments. He then called the Squadron and said he would go down on the flak emplacements while the rest of the Soundron strafed the field. He destroyed one flak emplacement and got a few hits on his plane; he swung over to knock out another emplacement and it got several hits on him. He then pulled up to about 1,000 feet, jettisoned his canopy and his ship seemed to stall out and fall off n its back. As its nose dropped through, Major Beerbower fell out the side of the airplane, struck the left side and draped over the left tail-plane. At about 400-500 feet he came loose and did not attempt to pull his rip-cord. The plane crashed and burned about 400 yards from where Major Beerbower hit.
